Carpentry Installer

Job Summary: The Carpentry Installer is responsible for executing operational and administrative job tasks as directed by company policy, customer requirements and the direction of Matrix Merchandising management. Carpentry Installers are offered work as it becomes available and usually install fixtures, cabinets, counters, walls and other large pieces related to point of purchase (POP) marketing efforts, but may also be asked to perform other tasks as needed.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Makes every store visit on time, and for the allocated amount of time.
- Exhibits high levels of productivity and accuracy.
- Complies with safety standards while working in the stores, and demands the same of other Matrix Merchandising employees.
- Executes Carpentry Installer-specific tasks as directed via voice, print or electronic instructions.
- Strives to insure that his/her work impacts the shopping experience as significantly as possible by:
 - o Adjusting prescribed requirements to suit the needs of the local store
 - o Insuring that all details are attended to, leaving the installation picture-perfect
 - o Providing information and feedback to store personnel so that they understand the objectives.
- Provides excellent customer service to stores and store personnel by exhibiting impeccable
 professionalism, integrity, and decorum as well as adhering to the Matrix Merchandising Dress and
 Grooming Standards.
- Insures that consumers are treated well by projecting a cheerful, helpful and friendly persona.
- Completes surveys, questionnaires, requests for photographs, etc. correctly and within deadline.
- Reports to his/her Supervisor with appropriate frequency all valid and pertinent information.

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to stand or walk throughout the workday.
- Must be able to crouch and to move items on or near floor level
- Must be capable of lifting and moving 50 pounds, and of lifting and moving up to 20 pounds above the head.
- Must be able to push or pull wheeled apparatuses weighing up to 1000 pounds.
- Must be able to work within a store environment without adverse effects due to allergies, asthma, or other chronic conditions.

Required Skills

- Ability to accurately measure and record/mark length, width and depth.
- Ability to use hand tools to cut, hammer, fasten, tack, glue and otherwise manipulate materials including vinyl, wood, metal and acrylic.
- Ability to use power tools to cut, fasten, bevel, rout, plane and otherwise manipulate materials required to build large display pieces to a "Finish Carpentry" level of competency.
- Ability to disassemble and then reassemble fixtures, displays, and other POP materials.
- Ability to understand and execute instructions in the form of written descriptions, drawings and/or photographs
- Ability to use a Smartphone, Tablet Computer, e-mail, web-based applications, spreadsheets and other forms of digital communication.
